ABOUT ALCORN

LOCATION

The main campus of Alcorn is located on 1700 acres in Claiborne County, Mississippi, seven miles west of Lorman, seventeen miles southwest of Port Gibson, and about halfway between Vicksburg, to the north, and Natchez, to the south. The campus in Natchez is home to the School of Nursing and School of Business, and a variety of courses are offered at the Vicksburg location.

ORGANIZATION

Schools offer programs leading to the associate, baccalaureate, master's, specialist, and doctoral degrees.

ENROLLMENT

Nearly 3,100 full- and part-time undergraduate and graduate students from 34 states and 23 countries attend Alcorn State University.

ACTIVITIES

More than 85 clubs and organizations, including student government, student newspaper and yearbook staffs, radio station, honor societies, religious groups, music and theater groups, student council, and special-interest groups.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

All official inquiries concerning admission to Alcorn State University should be directed to the Office of Admissions. To be eligible for admission, a person must be a graduate of a recognized high school. Persons who are not high school graduates are required to pass the General Education Development (GED) test and make a satisfactory score on the ACT and/or SAT before being admitted.

UNDERGRADUATE REQUIREMENTS

There are five ways to gain Freshman Undergraduate admission to Alcorn State University:

1. Complete the College Prep Curriculum via the QR code below with a minimum 3.2 GPA.
2. Complete the College Prep Curriculum with a minimum 2.5 GPA and score at least 16 or higher on the ACT or rank in the upper 50% of your class and score at least 16 or higher on the ACT.
3. Complete the College Prep Curriculum with a minimum 2.0 GPA and score 18 or higher on the ACT.
4. Meet full-qualifier certification requirements for the National Collegiate Athletic Association (NCAA).
5. Summer Developmental Program (*scan the QR code to learn more*)

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ABOUT SOD

Heralded as the Showband from Southland, the story of the Alcorn State University band program dates back to 1885, giving light to its storied history.

Known today as the Sounds of Dyn-O-Mite, SOD is a world-renowned musical ensemble revered for its rich traditions, prowess in music performance, and legacy of showmanship and pride. The program consists of many subunits but is most known for the earthquaking marching band.

The unit has performed before crowds at Soldier Field in Chicago, the Astrodome in Houston, the Los Angeles Coliseum, Texas Stadium in Dallas, Milwaukee County Stadium, Philadelphia Stadium, LADD Stadium in Mobile, the Orange Bowl in Miami, the Superdome in New Orleans, the RCA Dome in Indianapolis, Giant Stadium in New Jersey, the Edward Jones Dome in St. Louis, and the Silverdome in Pontiac. In 1975, it was the first college band to perform in the Superdome. It has also performed during halftime for the New Orleans Saints, Atlanta Falcons, and Detroit Lions.

Most of the innovation and success of the Sounds of Dyn-O-Mite were seen under the leadership of the visionary former director of bands Samuel S. Griffin.

Griffin enjoyed a legendary career with the Alcorn State University Sounds of Dyn-O-Mite and formally retired as Director of Bands in December 2012. During his 46 years of service to the band and university, Mr. Griffin became a father figure to so many and truly made a positive impact on so many lives. The Legendary Band Director passed away on August 4, 2017, surrounded by his family.

In 2011, the university decided to begin a transition to a new era. Dr. Renardo Murray was named the new Marching Band Director on May 31, 2011, and led the band through a transformation period. Under the direction of Dr. Murray, the band experienced a reemergence in the HBCU band culture, rising to over 250+ members. The band was voted to participate in the Honda BOTB in 2013 and 2016 under his leadership.

During the fall of 2018, Dr. Everson Martin was named the Director of Bands and has continued the traditions of the Sounds of Dyn-O-Mite and reestablished the Lady Purple Flashers in 2019. Dr. Martin's progression and sustained success of the Sounds of Dyn-O-Mite bodes well for the future of the band as he works to establish his own legacy.

GENERAL AUDITION REQUIREMENTS

As a student in the Sounds of Dyn-O-Mite Band, you will have the opportunity to gain scholarships, travel to many locations around the country, become a part of a prosperous university and band tradition, and regularly perform for audiences across the nation as a representative of the university. Within the Sounds of Dyn-O-Mite, you will form special bonds and relationships with the staff and fellow bandmates that will last a lifetime.

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AUDITION REQUIREMENTS

INCOMING FRESHMEN

1. Must be at least 17 years of age at the time of auditions
2. Acceptance letter from Alcorn State University (By Round 2)
3. Copy of Unofficial Transcript showing a High School GPA of 2.5 or greater
4. Submit 2 photos (Full body In dance Costume or All Black Dance Attire and Headshot)
5. Strong academic background
6. Positive attitude and work ethic
7. Performance experience and leadership skills
8. Video Audition (Round 1) and invitation to an in-person audition (Round 2)
9. \$75 Non-Refundable Application Fee for in-person auditions

CURRENT STUDENTS

1. Must currently be enrolled at Alcorn State University
2. Copy of Unofficial Transcript showing a 2.5 Cumulative GPA or greater (screenshots are acceptable)
3. Submit 2 photos (Full body In flag uniform or All Black Dance Attire and Headshot)
4. Strong academic background
5. Positive attitude and work ethic
6. Performance experience and leadership skills
7. Video Audition (Round 1) and invitation to an in-person audition (Round 2)

AUDITION REQUIREMENTS



ROUND 1

Round 1 audition video submission will consist of prospective candidates recording their audition routine of no more than 90 seconds and uploading the recording to an Unlisted YouTube Video (through the QR Code link below).

The submission video can be original content to express the creativity, agility, technical ability, and stamina. Music in the audition video should consist of the the "clean" version of the prospective candidate's song choices. *The submission dates for 2026 will begin on February 15th and close on March 15th at 11:59 p.m. CST.* Prospective candidates are required to include their full name, age, academic status (continuing student at Alcorn State University, pending admission to Alcorn State University, admitted to Alcorn State University, transfer student, etc.) in their submission. Prospective candidates are also required to submit two clear image photographs of themselves (including a headshot/face photo and full body picture).

Submissions with missing information or instructions for the recorded video will not be judged. Prospective candidates will receive a confirmation email within 72 hours of a submission being received.

AUDITION REQUIREMENTS

ROUND 2

Prospective candidates will be notified by April 1, 2026. These candidates will receive an invitation to the in-person audition, which will be held at the Fine Arts Building on the campus of Alcorn State University in the Samuel S. Griffin Band Hall on Sunday, April 26, 2026. The invitation email will provide detailed information concerning the time and place of the in-person auditions, as well as attire and a schedule for the day.

Prospective candidates who will be traveling from out of town have the option to stay overnight in Vicksburg, Natchez, or Jackson. These neighboring towns are closest to campus. There are also Airbnb options in Port Gibson. All prospective candidates invited to Round 2 are required to be admitted to Alcorn State University.

NOTE

By participating in this process you understand that auditions are **CLOSED** to the public. Selections are final and scores will not be shared with applicants/candidates/coaches/friends/family, etc. Further, all applicants/candidates are required to audition regardless of any previous affiliation, who you may know on the team, who trained you, how many clinics you attended, whether or not you were previously a member of the World Renowned Golden Girls, etc. Hence, **NO ONE** is guaranteed a spot from year to year. Please note that there are fees associated with participation. Please consider this before you agree to audition.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

What do I wear to auditions?

Wear clothing that allows you to move easily. Remember, this is an audition and you'll want to present yourself in the best possible manner. Don't cover yourself with excessive clothing or clothing that doesn't allow you to move comfortably. All black or black and white are customary audition colors.

Should I bring my own equipment to auditions?

We will provide equipment for the audition.

When do I find out the results of my audition?

Results are shared immediately after auditions or within 24 hours.

When does practice begin?

Practice begins during band camp in early August.

What is required on the video audition?

Videos should consist of a 60-90 second routine highlighting your flag corp skills skills. We want to see what you know, and where you are currently in your own training. The routine can be set to band music or the radio (clean) version of popular songs.

Are auditions open to my family and friends?

Auditions are closed to the public.

Are dance skills required to participate?

The Lady Purple Flashers is a precision flag corp, not a dance line. No dancing skills are required to make the team. Team members focus on skills aligned with twirling the flag, field show/drill formations and HBCU marching style.
